“Be The One”
Series: Love Gives

Series Description:

This series returns to a core part of the WHC culture – compassion. During this season, we carry out a project each week that serves people beyond our walls. The first three weeks of the series will look at the motivation, the heart behind compassion. Why do we do Love Gives? It’s not to earn favor with God or simply something good that needs to get done. Our motivation must be rooted in God’s grace to us to deliver the “no strings attached” kind of compassion we desire to share. The last four messages in the series will focus on Christmas passages and relate them to the Love Gives effort as well.

If your small group participates in one of the projects together, it has proven to be a good time to invite unchurched people to you. Compassion connects with people all spiritual “temperatures.”

Questions to Reflect Upon

Read: Luke 17:11-19.

1. How much do you know about leprosy? What was a leper’s life like 2,000 years ago? What would their healing mean to them?
2. What do you note about the request of the leper’s in :13? (What do they call Jesus and what do they ask for?)
3. Why do you think only one returned? What’s up with the other nine? If you had to put words in the mouths of the nine, what would be their reasons for not returning?
4. What do you make of the word used for all ten = “cleansed” (:14) versus what Jesus says to the one = “well” (:19)?
5. What is our modern-day leprosy (untouchables)? Who are modern day Samaritans (“those people”) What does this story tell you about God’s heart for those excluded by most/all?
6. Almost all people feel gratitude, less reveal gratitude. What three people can you thank this week for their positive impact in your life?

7. How has Jesus healed you spiritually? Physically? Emotionally?

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
